- Bunch of Mixed Herbs (in a vase)
- 3 Onions

**Section 2 – Fruit**

- 3 Cooking Apples (any variety)
- 3 Eating Apples (any variety)
- 3 Plums
- 3 Sticks of Rhubarb
- 5 Soft Fruit on a Plate

**Section 3 – Flowers & Plants**

- Fuchsia in a Pot (max 8” pot)
- 3 Dahlias (same variety)

- Flowering Geranium / Pelargonium in a Pot (max 8” pot)
- 3 Sprays of Foliage in a Vase (no flowers showing - max 12” diameter)
